Conditions of Registration

- Level One candidates must be at least 16 years of age and Level Two candidates must be 17. If, on the first day of the course, the candidates skiing/riding ability is determined to be below the level required for the course, the candidate will be asked to leave the course and be granted a part-refund. Candidates are strongly advised to seek confirmation of their ability at their local snowsports school by requesting a lesson with an NZSIA certified instructor or examiner.
- All courses above Level One are restricted to current members. Non-current members must pay outstanding fees on registration. Non-members and Level One candidates will be required to pay an additional \$75 associate fee on registration.
- Course numbers may be limited and registrations will only be accepted on receipt of completed registration form (or online registration) accompanied by full payment.
- Nzsia reserves the right to limit, cancel or postpone courses if circumstances warrant. Full refunds will be given in the event of a course cancellation.
- Full refund (less 5% administration fee) will be given if notice of withdrawal is received in *writing* 5 days prior to start of course. All other refunds are at the discretion of the course manager.
- Members of other isia recognised associations may be accepted into nzsia stage two and three courses on application to the course managers. Details and photocopies (or other proof) of qualifications will be required with registrations.
- Some participants may be eligible for discounted lift tickets during courses – please inform course director if lift tickets are required. Course costs include gst and video work. Participants are responsible for their own transportation, accommodation, food, and equipment.
- Registrations must be received at least than 10 days prior to course start date although early registration is encouraged. Some courses fill very early in the season especially levels One and Two.
