An agreement has been signed for 2019 between NZSIA and SAANZ. NZSIA is working with ski areas to try and keep growing membership base and support the industry.

- 50% discount on level 1,2 and 3 exams for full time members in the ski school
- Iwi run program in North Island give them 2 free level ones

Marlborough institute of technology – offering them a discount

Keep feedback coming back on how we invest in the industry – open to discussion

This initiative is for 1 year. NZSIA will be collecting data on how and where participants are coming from and then work with the ski areas on if we can expand for the future.
