



## **Ski Demo Team squad on snow try out 19 & 20 August, Treble Cone**

### **Plus 16 Aug Indoor Presentations Wanaka Hotel**

Participants must sign up on line via NZSIA website 10 days prior to try out.

Discounted lift passes will be available to participants.

#### **Purpose**

To select a Ski Demonstration Team of 12 to train, work together, and present to the membership in the build-up to Inter-ski 2019.

Ski Division plans to send a team of 8 to Inter-ski 2019. This Inter-ski team will be made up from the 2017 Ski Demo Team and potentially others who will be fulfilling the needs for the NZSIA Inter-ski Team.

The 2017 Ski Demo Team will display the following attributes:

- The ability to work as part of a team.
- Engaging, dynamic communication skills (oral and written communication skills and information gathering).
- Great skiing using NZSIA mechanics.

#### **Programme**

- Day 1 – Indoor Presentations 16 Aug (with evening of 18 OR 19 TBA for those that cannot make 16<sup>th</sup> Aug)
- Day 2 Skiing. Meet at 9am on snow at bottom of 6 seater chairlift.
- Day 3 Skiing. Meet at 9am on snow at bottom of 6 seater chairlift.

## **Skiing Assessment**

Dynamic large, medium and short radius turns will be assessed.

These turns will be assessed on and off piste in all conditions available on the day.

Skill Drills – all Current L3 Skill Drills

Synchro – participants may be asked to ski in synchro with partners assigned by the selectors.

## **Communication Assessment**

Written application

Participants will provide a written application, approx. 300 words, introducing themselves and describing the attributes they will bring to the Demo Team and the Inter-ski Team culture and process.

This is to be emailed to [ski@nzsia.org](mailto:ski@nzsia.org) no later than the 12 August 2017.

Late applications may not be considered.

## **Presentations**

Candidates will complete a 10-min presentation followed by 5 min question time. Candidates can choose from the following topics for their presentations.

- (1) Why would NZSIA participate in Inter-ski?
- (2) What benefits would the Demo Team deliver to the NZSIA members leading up to Inter-ski 2019?
- (3) What will the NZSIA as an organization look like in 5 years' time?
- (4) What is the most compelling aspect(s) of the NZSIA for members?
- (5) What information would be pertinent to deliver NZSIA Instructors working in NZ to set them up for success in their Profession
- (6) How would you envision the Demo Team culture to be and what would your contribution be to developing that culture

To assist you in the preparation of your presentation we provide the following information:

- A projector and screen will be available.
- Your presentation may include pictures, graphics, video (if less than a minute).
- Successful presenters will demonstrate excellent command of the spoken word (English).
- Successful presenters will demonstrate emotional and social intelligence skills.
- Successful presenters will engage with the audience.
- Thorough practice and preparation will be obvious.
