



## Trainer's Certification:

### Certification Overview.

The Trainer exam will include modules on clinicing telemark skills, demonstrations of Level One and Two Certifications, and personal Telemark improvement. Skier analysis is also covered via a real student (or video in necessary).

Candidates are expected to present a 30 minute teach-to-teach clinic during the workshop with peer interaction. The clinic should be aimed at Level One and Two exam candidates and the topic will be based around an introduction to any of the teaching progressions within the Level One or Two exams, and the NZSIA Telemark teaching format. Therefore, you will need to be very familiar with the content of the Level One and Two exams (course outlines are available online. After the workshop you will have a debrief session with your Examiners.

Please note: Daily content may vary according to weather, snow conditions, closed days etc. Portions of the workshop or exam may be held indoors if necessary. If closed days occur during the exam results may be based on candidate's performance during the workshop.

You will be required to send one 500-word essay on a topic related to Telemarking in New Zealand, The topic will be chosen by the course director. Forward to [telemark@nzsia.org](mailto:telemark@nzsia.org)

You will have a 10-minute question time to discuss your topic with the examiners.

#### Day 1: Coronet Peak

- Training vs teaching (changing techniques from teacher to trainer) 20 min
- Piste telemarking – edged, carving and short turns. Also, a 3x3x3 medium3 short 3 medium turns in succession.
- Teach-to-teach for Level One exam candidates 30 min
- Movement analysis- and teach to develop – real student of a given topic.
- During this day there will be time made to discuss the essay.

#### Day 2: Coronet Peak

- Demos for Level One up to medium radius turns with a pole plant.
- Off piste free ski showing confidence and flow.

## Certification Scoring Criteria

The Certification will be internally assessed by your examiner during the day. The assessment for this course is made up Safety, Free Skiing and Teaching components as listed. Candidates must pass all assessment areas. Results will be delivered in the format below.

- “Meets the Standard “- Teaching and Free Skiing both demonstrate understanding and competency in all of the key criteria to a level that would be acceptable in a lesson for Free Skiing.
- “Does Not Meet the Standard” – Either Teaching and or Free skiing did not demonstrate sufficient understanding and/or competency in all of the key criteria and therefore would not be acceptable for teaching a Lesson for Free Skiing.
